ALCOHOL RECOVERY COMMUNITY

We offer support on a one-to-one basis and group support, where you can share experiences with other people with similar experiences. Essex ARC also has access to in house counselling service, where appropriate. We can also support family, friends and carers affected by a loved one's drinking.

FUTURES IN MIND

Futures in Mind offers community groups and activities, open to adults 18+ who would like to meet others on their journey of recovery from mental ill health and/or substance/alcohol misuse.

SPECIALIST COMMUNITY FORENSIC TEAM

The SCFT are part of a multidisciplinary team alongside EPUT to support those being discharged from low/medium secure forensic units to integrate back into the community.

HEALTH AND JUSTICE

We work alongside EPUT and CRG as part of a multidisciplinary team. CRG assess physical and mental health needs for those in police custody and refer young people with complex and additional needs on to Phoenix Futures for support in the community.

We are also responsible for assessing adults, referred by Essex Probation, for Drug Rehabilitation Requirements and Alcohol Treatment Requirements.

FULL CIRCLE

Full Circle is commissioned to work with offenders with complex and additional needs across the whole of Essex. This includes making onward referrals and signposting to services, accompanying service users to appointments and advocating on behalf of service users.
